Southampton Record Office

HE Southampton Record Office was established in January 1953 as part of the Town Clerk's Department at the Civic Centre. In addition to the Corporation's own records (which are still being collected together) many private records have been deposited there. Until last year only one trained achivist was employed so that many records are still uncatalogued. This list includes all the documents which have been listed or catalogued and many of those which have not. Future annual lists in the *Proceedings* will include new accessions and those documents which it has not been possible to include in this list.

Many of the corporation records have already been published by the Southampton Record Society and the Corporation is producing a series of Southampton Papers to make its archives better known. It is hoped this year to begin the publication of a detailed guide in sections, but it will be many years before this is completed. In the meantime this list will provide some indication of the records available at the Office.

The Southampton Record Office is open to the public at the usual office hours from Monday to Friday, but readers coming from a distance are advised to make an appointment in their own interest.
